



Delivery of Prerana Inputs across the State:



The effort of the entire Sikshana Foundation’s team over the last decade is finally having its desired impact. The inputs (6 Posters | Training Manual | Prerana Club log book) of our Motivational Model "Prerana" have reached 23,920 Schools at 104 Blocks in 21 Districts. Process is underway for delivery of inputs to remaining 13 districts across the State catering to 27 lakh students across all 48 thousand schools. Sikshana Foundation’s team is keen to maximize utilization of program inputs and enhance the learning outcomes for all students in all the government schools Statewide.

Preparatory work for Sikshana Technology in Education Program (STEP) launch @ 57 Karnataka Public Schools (KPS):



STEP enables an engaging learning environment for the learner making the experience more hands on and lasting

while also imparting the necessary Information Communication Technology (ICT) and 21st Century Skills. Sikshana Foundation’s team has been trained to support the STEP implementation in 57 [KPS](#) selected across the State. The program is designed for students of grades 6th and 7th who will be assigned 02 Projects per semester from each subject (Science, Mathematics and Social Science). Each KPS will be provided with 2 Laptops, 1 Projector and Sikshanapedia (A Teacher led and curriculum based offline web-based App designed by Sikshana Foundation with a dual purpose of Digital Literacy and Tech Integrated Teaching).
