RECAP OF YEAR 2018:

2018 was an eventful year for Sikshana Foundation as Prerana started rolling out across the entire state of Karnataka and we also launched Prerana 2.0 intervention with a focus on enhancing the 21st Century Skills through PBL (Project Based Learning) and helping the students with foundational skills through CLAP (Customized Learning Achievement Path). We also expanded Prerana in Andhra Pradesh and introduced STEP (Sikshana Technology in Education Program) in Karnataka Public schools. This year our programs are impacting over 28 lakh Students across Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh and Maharashtra.

Below is the glimpse of our journey through the Year.

Expansion of Prerana:

In Karnataka inputs designed and developed by Sikshana Foundation and printed by Govt. of Karnataka have reached 80% Schools across the State. Students Clubs & peer Learning Groups were formed in most of the schools. Training

was given by Sikshana Foundation for 68 DIET lecturers and 10 DDPIs on Methodologies and Implementation of Prerana program. Program was expanded to 1958 Schools of 11 Tribal Mandals of Vizag District, Andhra Pradesh.

STEP:

Sikshana Foundation's Technology in Education program was implemented in 300+ Schools of Ramanagara, Magadi, Anekal in Karnataka and 61

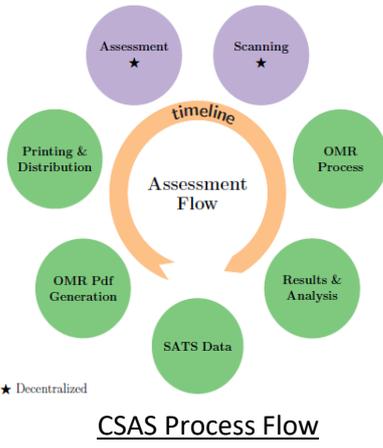


Project Planners & Helpers

Based on the results of CSAS 2017 (Census State Achievement Survey) conducted by Karnataka State Dept. of Education and Sikshana Foundation, 11.2 lakh Students in the State were found to be lacking foundational arithmetic skills. To address the same Sikshana Foundation designed and developed Prerana

2.0 which used Customized Learning and Project Based Learning inputs to address the lack of foundational skills and also to enhance 21st Century Skills among all children in the schools. This model is now running in over 2000 schools of Karnataka.

CSAS:



Sikshana played a major role in the conduct of the CSAS 2nd year in a row. This year nearly 4million students were assessed across 54k schools. This year the dept. also had a better control on the logistics and overall all the entire process was executed as planned and on time.

Trainings:

Sikshana strengthened its Training team and were able to successfully conduct sessions across the state at various locations simultaneously. The new 2 day session on Data management for Cluster Resource Personnel (CRPs) proved to be very popular across all districts. This module has the potential to become one of our core intervention next academic year.

Once the STEP program was implemented in this school he got attracted to the laptop and started to come regularly just so that he can use the device. He took to typing kannada as a natural and very quickly became an expert in the school. The teacher Mr. Vasudev who handles Science and Social Science subjects, helped Sharath to learn the typing and helped in learning MS-Office package as well. In just under a year his academic scores have improved and he is now made as School Leader and takes pride in helping teachers in doing many of their tasks which involves a laptop.
